These kits are personal care kits used around the world for people in the aftermath of natural disasters. They were even distributed in Findlay and Ottawa following the 2007 flood. We would so appreciate your involvement in building one or more kits. You never know when YOU or your loved ones may need them. We pray that doesn't happen, but we know they are appreciated around the world in many different circumstances.

Place the items listed in a 2-gallon Zip-Loc bag (provided for you, located on the table in the foyer)

Include ONLY those items listed on the inventory.
Deviating from this list can cause an entire shipment to be rejected in customs.

- 1 medium size bottle of shampoo (12 to 18 oz.), please tape flip-tops closed
 - 2 bars of soap (bath-size or larger)
 - 1 medium toothpaste (4.0 to 6.4 oz.)
 - 3 toothbrushes (must be in original packaging)
 - 1 box of Band-Aids (30 or more)
 - 1 fingernail clipper
 - 1 sturdy hair comb
 - 2 hand towels
 - 4 pocket-size packages of facial tissue
- (We have plenty of stuffed toys, so you will not need to include those.)

A basket is available in the foyer in which you can place your completed kits. We challenge Sunday School classes and home groups to encourage each person to fill at least one kit.
